ACADEMY CHERUBS (4-YEAR-OLDS & KINDERGARTENERS)

THE ACADEMY CHERUBS is an ensemble for Boston Avenue's youngest singers. They rehearse on Sunday mornings from 9:40 to 10:40 as part of Faith Academy and perform periodically in worship during the school year. Choristers focus on age-appropriate fundamentals of choral singing. This ensemble is conducted by Joan Hatley.

ACADEMY CHORALIERS (1ST & 2ND GRADERS)

THE ACADEMY CHORALIERS is a younger-elementary choir that rehearses on Sunday mornings from 11:00 to noon as part of Faith Academy. They sing periodically in worship throughout the school year. Choristers focus on age-appropriate fundamentals of choral singing. This ensemble is conducted by Joan Hatley.

ACADEMY CHORISTERS (3RD, 4TH, & 5TH GRADERS)

THE ACADEMY CHORISTERS is an upper elementary ensemble that rehearses on Sunday mornings from 11:00 to noon as part of Faith Academy. They sing once a month in worship during the school year. Choristers focus on age-appropriate fundamentals of choral singing. This ensemble is conducted by Ginny LeDoux.

CHILDREN'S CHOIR STAFF

GINNY LEDOUX, Director of Children's Music Ministries, came to work at Boston Avenue in the Fall of 2001 and directs the Academy Choristers. She holds degrees from Westminster Choir College and the Peabody Conservatory of Music. Her outstanding work with children's choirs in Tulsa has earned her acclaim throughout Oklahoma. She is an active clinician and has been a leader in the American Choral Directors Association for many years. In addition to her work at the church, she is a music teacher at Holland Hall. Mrs. LeDoux is the founder and Artistic Director/Conductor Emerita of the Tulsa Children's Chorus.

JOAN HATLEY, Director of the Academy Cherubs and Academy Choraliars, began directing our youngest singers in the Fall of 2006. She received her Bachelor of Music degree in piano performance from the University of Oklahoma. Joanie is currently the accompanist for the Tulsa Oratorio Chorus and the Boston Avenue Chapel Choir. She has performed piano concerts throughout the Midwest and has served as pianist for the Tulsa Opera, the Oklahoma All-State Chorus, the Crescendo Music Awards, and the Tulsa Performing Arts Center's *Brown Bag It* recital series. She is a parateacher in the French second grade at Eisenhower International School.
